SUPPLEMENTAL JUDGMENT AND DECREE

(Paragraph 290)

In the above-entitled matter, Notice of Intention to Offer Proof of Completion of Appropriation and Application of Water Appropriated to Beneficial Use, having been filed within the time and in the manner prescribed by law, by the Montague Water Conservation District, and Notice of the Time Set for Hearing said.

Proof of Completion of Appropriation and Application of Water Appropriated to Beneficial Use having been given by the Clerk in the manner and for the time prescribed by law, and said matter coming on regularly to be heard this day, and Messrs. Tebbe & Correia appearing for and on behalf of said Montague Water Conservation District, and proof of said Completion of Appropriation and Application of Water Appropriated to Beneficial Use having been offered and having been heard and considered by the Court;

The Court finds that the Montague Water Conservation District, organized and existing under and by virtue of the California Irrigation District Act, as amended, has used 2.30 cubic feet per second of water from the natural flow of Little Shasta River, through the Montague Water Conservation District's main canal

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throughout the entire year, each and every year; that all of said water has been used for industrial, municipal and domestic purposes within the Town of Montague, Siskiyou County, California; that said use has been and is beneficial use of all of said appropriated water; and that the said Montague Water Conservation District has completed the appropriation of water set forth in Faragraph 290 of Paragraph III of the Decree entered December 30, 1932, in the above-entitled Court, the extent of said 2.30 cubic feet per second of water for industrial, municipal and domestic purposes within the boundaries of said District, and within the boundaries of the Town of Montague, all in accordance with the provisions of said Decree, the orders of this Court, and the terms of Fermit 2581 issued by the Division of Water Resources upon Application 4909 of said District.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows, to-writ: that the Montague Water Conservation District, organized and existing under and by virtue of the California Irrigation Act, as amended, is entitled to divert from the natural flow of Little Shasta River, through the Montague Water Conservation District's Main Canal, throughout the entire year, 2.30 cubic feet per second, with a priority of February 4, 1926, or as much as said amount of water as said District directly applies to beneficial use for the purposes hereinafter set forth; all of said water to be diverted from said Little Shasta River at a point (designated on Division of Water Right Map as Diversion ____) which bears approximately N. 85°25° E., approximately 1735 feet distant from the South quarter corner of Sec. 26, T. 45 N., R. 5 W., M.D.B.&M., being within the SE_k^1 SE_k^1 of said Sec. 26, and all of said water to be used for industrial, municipal and domestic purposes within the Town of Montague, Siskiyou County, California, and within the boundaries of said Montague Water Conservation District as shown on Permit 2581 on file with the Division of Water Resources,
