



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## **Fee Waiver Available for Qualified Diversions**

Water right owners within the jurisdiction of the Scott Valley and Shasta Valley Watermaster District (SSWD), who pay an annual watermaster service fee, and wish to be considered for a waiver of this fee must submit a *REQUEST FOR WAIVER OF WATER-MASTER SERVICE FEE* form, with signature, during the annual **Fee Waiver Enrollment Period of March 1st through April 15th** along with a payment of \$60 to cover the cost of verifying the diversion and water right qualifies for the waiver. Eligibility is determined by the Deputy Watermaster. All requests for fiscal year 2018-2019 will be considered at the Board of Directors' regular monthly meeting held in May 2018.
